CIVILIAN MARKSMANSHIP PROGRAM HIGH POWER RIFLE LEAGUE MATCH (200 YD.)
For Match and Service Rifles

DATES:

Saturday April 13, 2024. 8:00 AM registration and target assignments

LOCATION:

Rattlesnake Mountain Shooting Facility, located on SR 225 (Horn Road) approximately 3 mi southwest of the intersection of SR 240 and SR 225 (toward Horn Rapids Park) and approximately 3 mi north of Benton City, WA.

OPEN TO:

Any individual

RULES:

CMP High Power Rules apply. Any safe rifle/load and any sight up to .35 caliber may fire.

ENTRY FEES:

\$15.00 Junior fees are ½ price

MATCH SCHEDULE:

0815 Orientation and Safety meeting for all competitors

0830 the 50 shot National Match Course @ 200 yd reduced course with sighting shots

Match 1 – 2 SS and 10 shots for record, standing at 200 yards. Time limit: 12 min.

Match 2 – 2 SS and 10 shots for record, sitting or kneeling, rapid fire at 200 yards. Time limit: 60 sec. Competitors will start from position with magazines on the ground.

Match 3 – 2 SS and 10 shots for record, prone, rapid fire at 200 yards (300 yd. reduced).

Time limit: 70 sec. Competitors will start from position with magazines on the ground.

Match 4 – 2 SS and 20 shots for record, prone at 200 yards (600 yd reduced). Time limit: 22 min.

Match 5 – Aggregate of matches 1 through 4

REGISTRATION:

Entries accepted until 0815 up to a range capacity of 60 competitors. Stats office will open at 0800 on match days for post entries and to conduct target assignments.

CLASSIFICATION:

CMP High Power Classification will be used. Five or more competitors will make a class. Any class with fewer than 5 competitors will be combined with the next higher class. If fewer than 5 High Masters enter, they will compete for Match Winner only. There must be at least 5 shooters with non-qualifying rifles to form a special class.

ARM:

Competitors may fire a Service Rifle (CMP Rule 4.1.1, 4.1.3, 4.1.4), Alternative Rifle (CMP Rule 4.1.2), or Match Rifle (CMP Rule 4.1.5)

AMMUNITION:

Any safe ammunition may be used. Ammunition may be commercial manufactured or hand loaded and will be provided by the competitor. Tracer, incendiary or armor piercing ammunition is prohibited.

TARGETS:

200-yard SR, 200-yard SR 42 (300 yd. reduced), and MR 52 (600 yd. reduced).

SCORING:

Electronically scored targets (ShotMarker) will be used. Please bring your own means, such as cell phone or tablet to log and record shot scores. Range provided tablets are available for those who do not bring their own.

AWARDS:

No monetary awards given. Scores will be submitted to CMP for inclusion in national league.

NOTES:

Facilities at the range are primitive. Lavatories are available (portable) but there is no water. Please prepare accordingly.
