KOREAN WAR MEMORIAL HIGH POWER SERVICE RIFLE MATCH



DATES: March 9th and 10th, (Sat. & Sun.) 2024

LOCATION: Rattlesnake Mountain Shooting Facility, located on SR 225 (Horn Road) approximately 3 mi. southwest of the intersection of SR 240 and SR 225 (toward Horn Rapids Park) and approximately 3 mi. north of Benton City.

RULES: Modified CMP & NRA High Power Service Rifle Rules apply.

ENTRY FEES: \$25.00 per day, \$50.00 both days. Juniors are ½ price.

MATCH SCHEDULE: MARCH 9th, SATURDAY

11:00 AM: Registration, Korean War Historical Oration, Orientation and Safety meeting

Noon: 80 shot Regional Match Course with sighting shots.

Match 1 – 2 SS and 20 shots for record, standing to sitting or kneeling, rapid fire at 200 yards. Time limit: 60 sec per 10 shot string.

Match 2 – 2 SS and 20 shots for record, standing at 200 yards. Time limit: 22 min.

Match 3 – 2 SS and 20 shots for record, standing to prone, rapid fire at 300 yards. Time limit: 70 sec per 10 shot string.

Match 4 – 2 SS and 20 shots for record, prone at 600 yards. Time limit: 22 min.

Match 5 – Aggregate of matches 1 through 4.

MATCH SCHEDULE: MARCH 10th, SUNDAY

08:45 AM: Registration, Orientation and Safety meeting for all competitors.

09:00 AM: 50 shot National Match Course without sighting shots.

Match 6

– 10 shots for record, standing to sitting or kneeling, rapid fire at 200 yards. Time limit: 60 sec per 10 shot string.

– 10 shots for record, standing at 200 yards. Time limit: 10 min.

– 10 shots for record, standing to prone, rapid fire at 300 yards. Time limit: 70 sec per 10 shot string.

– 20 shots for record, prone at 600 yards. Time limit: 20 min.

Match 7 – Grand Aggregate of matches 5 and 6.

REGISTRATION: *Pre-registration encouraged!* Entries accepted until March 8th. Stats office will open at AM on match days for post entries and target assignments. Target assignments will be random on Sat. and then same target will carrying over to Sun.

CLASSIFICATION: NRA High Power Classification will be used. 5 or more competitors will make a class. Any class with fewer than 5 competitors will be combined with the next higher class. Fewer than 5 High Masters will compete for Match Winner only.

ARM: Must meet CMP Service Rifle rules 4.1.1, 4.1.2, 4.1.3 4.1.6 and 4.1.4. (AR-15, M1A, AR-10, or M1)

AMMUNITION: Any safe ammunition may be used. Tracer, incendiary or armor piercing ammunition is prohibited.

TARGETS: 200-yard SR, 300-yard SR-3 and 600-yard MR-1

SCORING: It is most likely electronically scored targets (ShotMarker) will be used. Please bring your own means, such as cell phone or tablet to log and record shot scores.

AWARDS: Grand Agg. winner will receive the Korean Memorial Trophy.

Competitors shooting M1 Garands will make up a class for competing for M1 Garand honors. The M1 Garand class winner will receive a US Mint Korean War Memorial Silver Dollar.

NOTES: Facilities at the range are primitive. Lavatories are available (portable) but there is no water.
