LOCATION: Rattlesnake Mountain Shooting Facility, 10 miles Northwest of Richland, WA. Access to the range is through the High Power / Shotgun Gate, located at MP 8.5, North of I-82 (Benton City), or 3 Miles South of Hwy 240, on Hwy 225. Map available at: <https://www.tcsahighpower.org/find-us>.

RULES: These are not NRA Approved / Registered matches, but they will generally follow current NRA rule-books. Eye and hearing protection are strongly recommended for all shooters and required for junior shooters.

ELIGIBILITY: Open to all competitors. Scores will be tracked & tallied by the generally recognized NRA disciplines of Any/Any Sling, F-Open and F-TR. Newly established disciplines of F-Production, F-Limited, and F-Precision/Any Rifle will be accommodated when possible. These new disciplines will be incorporated into NRA Rule-Books in the coming months.

EQUIPMENT and AMMUNITION: Any safe rifle may participate. At the sole discretion of the Match Director, unsafe or inaccurate rifles or competitors will be removed from the match.

As matches will be fired on ShotMarker electronic targets, **shooters will need to bring a Wi-Fi enabled device (phone or tablet).**

Any safe ammunition may be used, except the use of tracer, incendiary, or armor piercing ammunition is prohibited. **We will make a reasonable attempt to assist shooters, but fired rounds failing to reach the target at supersonic velocity (and reliably register on the ShotMarker targets) and/or fail to impact the target berm will cause the competitor to be removed from the firing line.**

INDIVIDUAL ENTRY REQUIREMENTS: Participants are requested to email (mikesowa@ix.netcom.com) or text (541-571-1892) match director prior to the match with intent to participate.

ENTRY FEE: \$40 per day for the match, payable at the range on the day of match. Junior competitors will shoot free.

ENTRY LIMIT: Forty (40) individual shooters total.

TARGETS & TARGET SERVICE:

Match will be fired on ShotMarker electronic targets with discipline appropriate NRA LR or LRFC paper target faces.

SCORING: Competitors will score for the other shooters on their relay.

EMPTY CHAMBER INDICATOR (ECI): Required at all times except while in match preparation time or while firing.

SQUADDING: All matches will not be squadded.

REPORTING OF SCORES: Scores will be tallied, and top scores announced at the end of the match. Scores WILL NOT be reported to the NRA. Matches will qualify for the **V2 F-Class Point Series**. www.fclasspointsseries.com

*Able bodied participants are encouraged to meet in the butts at range opening to help set up e-targets and raise wind flags.

COURSE OF FIRE

1000 Yard Matches - Prone Slow fire (Pair Firing at the Match Director's Discretion)

- Match # 1 – Unlimited sighters and 20 shots for record from 1000 yards.
- Match # 2 – Unlimited sighters and 20 shots for record from 1000 yards.
- Match # 3 – Two convertible sighters and 15 shots for record from 1000 yards.
- Match # 4 – Two convertible sighters and 15 shots for record from 1000 yards.
- Match # 5 – Two convertible sighters and 15 shots for record from 1000 yards.

Deviations from this course of fire (i.e. Palma course or Pair Firing) may be made at the Match Directors discretion with concurrence from participating shooters.

TIME: 20 shot matches have a 30-minute time limit, 15 shot matches have a 22-minute limit.

OTHER DETAILS:

Sustenance & Weather: Rattlesnake is a primitive & barren range. Bring your own WATER and food. No organized lunch break will be taken. Plan for inclement weather (i.e., heat, cold, sun, rain, & wind). **There is no shade or shelter on the High Power range, so plan accordingly.**

Accommodations: There are NO WATER or ELECTRICAL connections available on the range. Portable toilets are available. Lodging and restaurants can be found nearby in Richland (15 mi.) and groceries in Benton City (6 mi.)

Airport: The Tri-Cities airport is in Pasco (PSC) 25 miles from the range. PSC is served by Alaska, Allegiant, American, Delta and United Airlines.
