**RATTLESNAKE'S MID RANGE MATCHES**

**TCSA HIGH POWER**  
**07 MAR and 18 OCT 2025**

**LOCATION:** Rattlesnake Mountain Shooting Facility, 10 miles Northwest of Richland, WA. Access to the range is through the High Power / Shotgun Gate, located at MP 8.5, North of I-82 (Benton City), or 3 Miles South of Hwy 240, on Hwy 225. Map available at: <https://www.tcsahighpower.org/find-us>.

**RULES:** These are not NRA Approved / Registered matches, but they will generally follow current NRA High Power rules. Eye and hearing protection are required.

**ELIGIBILITY:** Open to all competitors. Scores will be tracked & tallied by the generally recognized NRA disciplines of Sling, F-Open & F-TR.

**EQUIPMENT and AMMUNITION:** Any safe rifle may participate. At the sole discretion of the Match Director, unsafe or inaccurate rifles / competitors will be removed from the match.

As matches will be fired on ShotMarker electronic targets, shooters will need to bring a Wi-Fi enabled device (phone/tablet).

Any safe ammunition may be used, except the use of tracer, incendiary, or armor piercing ammunition is prohibited. **Fired rounds that fail to reach the target at supersonic velocity and/or fail to impact the target berm will cause the competitor to be removed from the firing line.**

**INDIVIDUAL ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:** Participants requested to email ([mikesowa@ix.netcom.com](mailto:mikesowa@ix.netcom.com)) or text (541-571-1892) match director prior to the match with intent to participate.

**ENTRY FEE:** \$20 per day for the match, payable at the range on the day of match. Junior competitors are half price.

**ENTRY LIMIT:** Forty (40) individual shooters total.

**TARGETS & TARGET SERVICE:**

Match will be fired on ShotMarker electronic targets with discipline appropriate NRA MR-1 or MR-1FC paper target faces.

**SCORING:** Competitors will score for the other shooters on their relay.

**EMPTY CHAMBER INDICATOR (ECI):** Required to be used at all times prior to match preparation time and after firing is complete.

**SQUADDING:** All matches will be squadded.

**REPORTING OF SCORES:** Scores will be tallied, and top scores announced at the end of the match. Scores WILL NOT be reported to the NRA.

**COURSE OF FIRE**

600 Yard Matches - Prone Slow fire

- Match # 1 - Unlimited sighters and 20 shots for record from 600 yards, time limit of 22 minutes.
- Match # 2 - Unlimited sighters and 20 shots for record from 600 yards, time limit of 22 minutes.
- Match # 3 - Unlimited sighters and 20 shots for record from 600 yards, time limit of 22 minutes.

Long Range Practice - Prone Slow fire

Depending on participant interest, there may be an opportunity to practice at longer ranges (800-1000 yards) following the 600 yard match.

**OTHER DETAILS:**

Sustenance & Weather: Rattlesnake is a primitive & barren range. Bring your own WATER and food. No organized lunch break will be taken. Plan for inclement weather (i.e., heat, cold, sun, rain, & wind). **There is no shade or shelter on the High-Power range, so plan accordingly.**

Accommodations: There are NO WATER or ELECTRICAL hook-ups available on the range. Portable toilets are available. Lodging and restaurants can be found nearby in Richland (15 mi.) and groceries in Benton City (6 mi.)

Airport: The Tri-Cities airport is located in Pasco (PSC). It is 25 miles from the range, and is served by Alaska, Allegiant, American, Avelo, Delta and United airlines.
